Pillar I – Safety Wellness

EP Focus: Actively monitor safety & wellness throughout Taos Municipal Schools and Community to determine the best decision for reopening of schools.

Waiting for quotes for high school back gate paving project. \$35,000 was awarded to TMS for THS from DOT, TMSD will match \$35,000 with SB9 funds to complete a significant portion of the back entry/exit of high school.

Walk through of existing SPED room with CJ, Lisa Valerio and Lynn Brasher, looks like overcrowding of classroom due to student enrollment in the next SY. Looking for other places to house SPED students at THS, looked at old welding room at VOAG. Will need extensive renovation to meet code. LDG has been contacted by Robert Valencia Director of Facilities for quote on documents and a maximum allowable construction cost (MACC). Not sure right now which funding will be determined to move forward.

Roofing/parapet project at ENOS to start in June and completed at the end of the month.

RFP for pilot security project at ENOS to be posted by mid-May and work to start July upon selection of contractor.

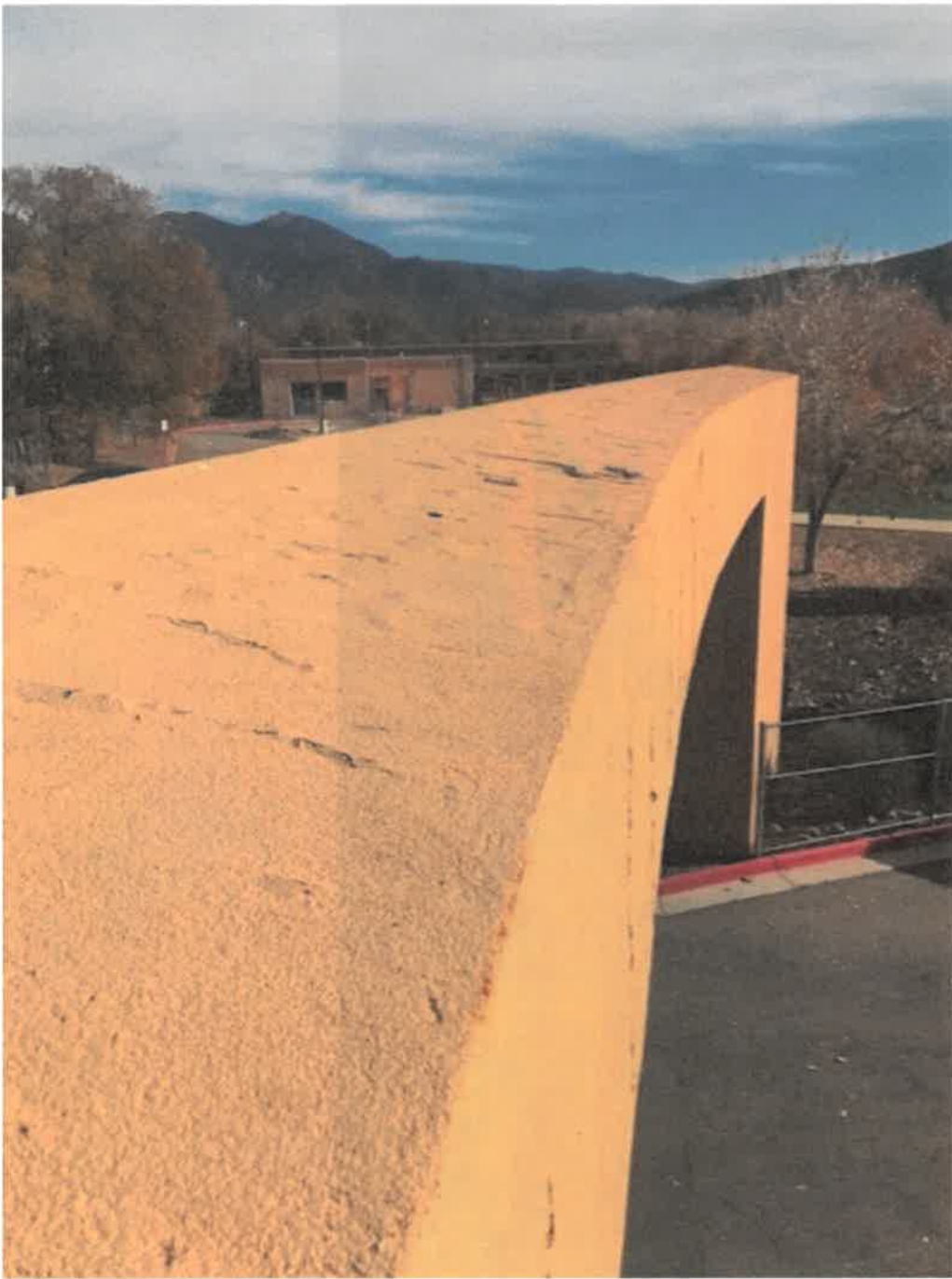
