School Indicator: **Aggregate of Tier 1-4 Supports**

Below are the data for IStation ELA and Math. The data was pulled from September and May where we tested most students in-person. Our students test at the beginning of each month, but the data from in-person testing is more valid since we don't know how much families help students at home with the assessments. As we predicted, and what has been seen nationwide, fewer of our students are in Tier I (at benchmark). Since we have begun full re-entry instruction, in-person students are receiving explicit and consistent instruction in ELA and Math.
