Community Based Prevention, Intervention, & Reunification

Collection of services focused on child abuse.

Prevention: Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP) services support families with children 0-5 years of age. Services are designed to promote safety and well-being in families facing high-risk factors and living in high-risk environments. www.lascumbres-nm.org/prevention

Intervention: Family Support Services (FSS) and Intensive Family Support Services (IFSS) provide in home comprehensive support to strengthen and preserve families who are currently experiencing problems in family functioning and multiple challenges related to safety.

Reunification: Family Reunification Services (FRS) and Time-Limited Reunification (TLR) services are provided to children returning from Foster Care or other out of home placements who are reunifying with their parents, family members, other caregivers pursuing guardianship.
