**Pillar I – Safety Wellness**

*EP Focus: Actively Monitor Safety & Wellness throughout Taos Municipal Schools.*

*School Indicator: Aggregate of Tier 1-4 Supports*

- ADNE has constructed storage space in our community garden so that gardening tools and supplies may be stored safely and appropriately.
- All ADNE classrooms have been properly stripped of all student work, anchor charts and student materials have been taken home so that our classrooms can be cleaned over the summer.
- The Taos Soil and Water Conservation District has visited all ADNE classrooms to properly educate all students about water safety and the potential hazards of runoff this summer.
- ADNE will be hosting Mr. Mark Richert on Friday, May 26<sup>th</sup> for an SEL activity from 2:00 – 3:00 PM at ADNE’s library.

**Pillar II – Student Achievement**

*EP Focus: Identify, plan and provide instruction to reduce learning loss as a result of Covid-19*

*School Indicator: 2.1 Increase individualized attention*

- ADNE hosted an end of the year student achievement (AVID) and attendance ceremony, students were honored for leadership, citizenship and attendance. ADNE had 17 students and 3 teachers with perfect attendance for the 4<sup>th</sup> nine weeks.
- ADNE is hosting a Kindergarten/5<sup>th</sup> Grade promotion ceremony on Friday, March 26, this is the first year ADNE has had such a ceremony, the ceremony will run from 9:00 – 10:45 AM in our gymnasium.
- ADNE completed all our End of The Year assessments, our schedule ran smoothly, and all students were tested within the testing window.
- 80% of all ADNE students improved in their iReady diagnostic assessments (reading) and 62% of all ADNE students improved in their iReady Math diagnostic assessments.
- ADNE’s 3<sup>rd</sup> grade class visited the Great Sand Dunes on Tuesday, May 9<sup>th</sup>, ADNE thanks Mrs. Trujillo and the Taos School Board for their approval and support.
