- COVID-19 Nationwide Waivers Extended for 2021-2022 School Year – Waivers have been extended to ensure students continue to receive free school meals through the 2021-22 School Year. All schools that opt-in is permitted to serve and claim meals through Seamless Summer Option through the 2021-22 School Year. The waivers also allow schools to continue receiving the higher per-meal reimbursement rate offered under the Summer Food Service Program. [USDA's Child Nutrition COVID-19 waivers](#)
