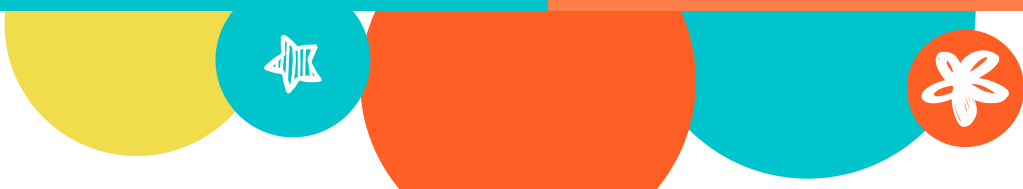
The state of New Mexico will grant approximately \$170M of federal aid to New Mexicans for rental and utility assistance to households experiencing financial hardship due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) will administer the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) in partnership with the City of Albuquerque. New Mexicans can apply for assistance at www.RentHelpNM.org

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Proof of income (paycheck stubs, most recent filed federal income tax, profit and loss statement, bank statements, unemployments award letter)
- utility invoices, receipts for expenses (wood, pellets, hotel/motel costs, etc)
- attestations from landlord, employer, caseworkers, or others with knowledge of the household's circumstances
- IRS form 1099-G
- mortgage, deed, or title to the property being rented for lease-purchase situations
- any other forms requested by DFA

WHO CAN APPLY

- Households paying rent under a lease agreement or payments under a lease-purchase agreement
- Experienced financial hardship due to COVID-19
- Can demonstrate risk of homelessness or housing instability
- Household income below \$30,750 (single person) to \$47,450 (5 person household)
- Current resident in New Mexico
- Proof of delinquency on rent, utilities, and other costs
- Current on payments on 3/21/2020
